Sean Tuttle, from Heroes and Horses, was our program presenter. This organization is a small, but powerful, non profit located in Manhattan, MT. Their Mission Statement:

Heroes and Horses is a unique program that uses the remote wilderness and the horse/human connection to challenge and inspire personal growth in veterans suffering from mental and physical scars.

Mountain Sky Guest Ranch provides the setting for their "in camp" intense training. Participants are taught how to ride and how to pack. The program is in 3 phases, the emphasis being on the packing and heading out into the rugged mountains. Their training motto is "DO EVERYTHING 5 TIMES" while learning. When not in camp, they cover 30-40 miles on most days. Phase 2, last year, involved heading into the BOB. Most of the participants have had no horse experience prior to their arrival.

They are increasing their herd this year with quite a few BLM mustangs. Some of these horses will be in training with the MSU colt starting class and the others will be heading to Gallatin River Ranch. Horses have 500 miles of training on them before they are used by participants. This program emphasizes Struggle = Value, Change the Challenge, Nobody's a Victim. Check out their website at heroesandhorses.org. for more information on the program and how you can help. They are hosting a packing clinic, open to the public, on January 28 and 29. They also have yearly fundraiser.

Summer projects for 2017 - build hitching rails at various trailheads. Cabin Creek, Spanish Creek, suggestions for any other sites?


