Notice of Risks Inherent in Equine Activities:

Serious injury or death can result from equine riding and related activities. There are risks inherent in equine activities, and these dangers or conditions that are an integral part of equine activities include, but are not limited to:

- a) propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury or harm or the death of persons on or around the equine;
- b) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as medication, sound, sudden movements, and unfamiliar objects, person, or other animals;
- c) the potential of another participants not to maintain control over the equine or to not act within the person's ability.

Participants in any equine activity shall act in a safe and responsible manner at all times to avoid injury to themselves and others and shall be aware of the risks inherent in equine activities.

The Upper Clark Fork Backcountry Horsemen (UCFBCH) shall not be liable for injury to or the death of a participants as a result of their voluntary participation in any sponsored activity. UCFBCH has the right to deny membership to any applicant. I certify that I have read and understand the above notice.
