What type of packing will we learn?

Packing demos will be taught using Decker Pack Saddles. Both mantled loads and panniers will be taught.

Who will teach us?

Women and men packers who pack for the USFS and members of the Back Country Horsemen of the Flathead will help with the hands-on portion.

Am I too young?

Nope, all ages are welcome

What should I bring?

Yourself, a notebook, and a good writing utensil. Feel free to use your phone for pictures or videos. You won't want to forget this!

What should I wear?

Warm weather gear with sturdy boots or shoes. The arena space is not heated. Leather gloves are recommended.

Should I bring anything to eat with me?

There will be lunch for sale, and you are welcome to bring your own lunch if you would like.

Are you sure it's okay for me to join, given I have no horse experience?

Of course! This is an educational opportunity, so no pressure. Everyone must start somewhere, so let us teach you!

What if I'm a little intimidated by the live pack stock?

A life-size plastic horse named Slick, is available for anyone to use at the clinic.



Items will remain available for sale until the event ends at 3:00 p.m., at which time you can pick up unsold items.
