Safety Protocol: Roy, Tony

Roy Barkley: recreation program manager for Helena District.

Roy wants to focus up on safety and response plan for each project we take on in the field. Will be more homework for project leaders.

Roy has an emergency response plan document for us. Requires membership to identify areas and locations that allow for helicopters and medivacs to come in to do a rescue. So this requires putting in latitude and longitude ahead of time.

Roy suggests we identify a lead for the front of the project and a drag bringing up the rear so communications are constant.

Plan also has a communications (the 9 line) piece to facilitate the process if an incident must be called in.

Q: can we receive assigned radios for front and back riders to have? This will be provided by the Forest Service.

Tony is our designated representative on this.

Tony can identify likely evacuation areas for each trip.

Saw training
