NEW BUSINESS

- Work Projects:
 - Woods Creek Fire area: multiple email communications have been sent on this project; Neil H is the project lead; Neil indicated he had a confirmed head count of 23 LCBCH members and 4 USFS members; USFS team will be at each bridge location and stack the planks when they are packed in; Friday, Aug 12 is the day to set up camp and prep lumber for packing; Saturday, Aug 13 is pack lumber in day; there are approx 300, 4' planks to be packed in around 6 to 9 miles; this project is to be done by September 1; the plan is to complete this on one weekend (Aug 12 – 13) if possible; for more info regarding this project see the August newsletter
 - Additional notes regarding project: Tony S will send additional info on location of trailhead and directions; Neil H mentioned the trailhead is not real big for multiple larger stock trailers, he suggested to park in locations to allow room for maneuvering larger trailers; Neil H also mentioned there are corrals at the trailhead but they are already spoken for, there is good grass in the area, bring your electric fence or whatever you use for your animals, may need to tie to trailers at night; club will have a large tent to set up for food, etc.; club will supply food and water, a porta potty, and stock tanks at trailhead; bring your own tent and chair
 - Reminder if you are participating in the project: track mileage, stock use, hours of work, etc. This information will need to be submitted to the project lead.
